ACVECC supported evidence – based veterinary CPR guidelines published by the RECOVER Initiative aimed at equipping participants with concepts and techniques in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life Support (ALS) reinforced through scenario-based simulations.

Point of Care Ultrasound (POCUS) including Focused Assessment with Sonography for Trauma (FAST)

1pm-6pm

Created as a triage screening test by human trauma surgeons in the 1990s, these are now an essential part of everyday ER veterinary practice.

Registration includes: morning and afternoon tea; boxed lunch packs; transport to venue from Surfers Paradise (if needed); printed notes; RECOVER Certification from ACVECC/VECCS – if attending CPR Training and assessed competencies are met.
